The Institute for Resources and Environment (IRE) was established in 1995 by the amalgamation of the interdisciplinary graduate program of Resource Management and Environmental Studies (which included the Forest Economics and Policy Analysis research unit) and Westwater Research Centre. The role of the Institute is to initiate and foster holistic approaches to issues related to the human use of

natural resources and the reciprocal relationships with the environment within which society functions.

The Institute's programs are linked to other programs within the Faculty of Graduate Studies and in other disciplinary units and, outside the University, through faculty joint appointments, associate appointments and collaborative research programs. Close coordination is maintained with the Fisheries Centre and the School of Community and Regional Planning. The Institute's programs are developed in conjunction with an advisory council to reflect emerging resource and environmental issues.
